At its Special Meeting of April 15, 2020, the Lake Orion Village Council adopted Resolution 2020-016 regarding **MEDICAL AND RECREATIONAL MARIHUANA**. Resolution 2020-016 indicated that the Council will be, in the near future, passing ordinances that will allow for both medical and recreational marihuana, and possibly allowing for retailers, provisioning centers, distributors, growers, processors, secured transporters, and safety compliant facilities under the MMFLA and MRTMA. Future ordinances would authorize within the Village the potential for limited numbers of marihuana retailers, provisioning centers, distributors, growers, processors, transporters, micro-businesses and designated consumption establishment. In addition, the Village will in the ordinances provide for standards and procedures to permit and regulate such facilities; to provide for the imposition of permit application fees; to provide penalties; and to pose conditions for the operation of such facilities.

The Lake Orion Village Council will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, August 10, 2020 @ 7:30 PM in the Village Council Chambers located at Village Hall, 21 E. Church Street, Lake Orion, MI 48362.
